

### **Masévon Group B.V. statement on RoHS compliance**

At Masévon Group B.V., we recognize our responsibility to care for the natural environment and to minimize the impact of our activities on ecosystems and human health. As part of this commitment, we ensure that our products comply with the European Union's Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive, which limits the use of certain hazardous materials in electrical and electronic equipment.

Our products may incorporate electrical and electronic components, which may be prescribed by or selected in collaboration with our customers. To uphold compliance and sustainability standards, Masévon Group B.V. requires all suppliers to adhere to RoHS regulations as part of our General Terms of Purchase. This requirement is fundamental to our procurement process and reflects our dedication to responsible sourcing.

In cases where there is any uncertainty regarding RoHS compliance, Masévon Group B.V. will request formal declarations or supporting documentation from suppliers to confirm adherence to the directive. This approach ensures transparency and reinforces our commitment to environmental stewardship.

The RoHS Directive currently in force is [Directive 2011/65/EU](#), as amended by [Directive \(EU\) 2015/863](#), which restricts the use of ten hazardous substances, including lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), and four phthalates (DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP).

Masévon Group B.V.'s compliance is based on information provided by suppliers and verified through reasonable due diligence. While we take every measure to ensure accuracy, we will actively follow up on any uncertainties to maintain compliance and uphold our environmental responsibility.
